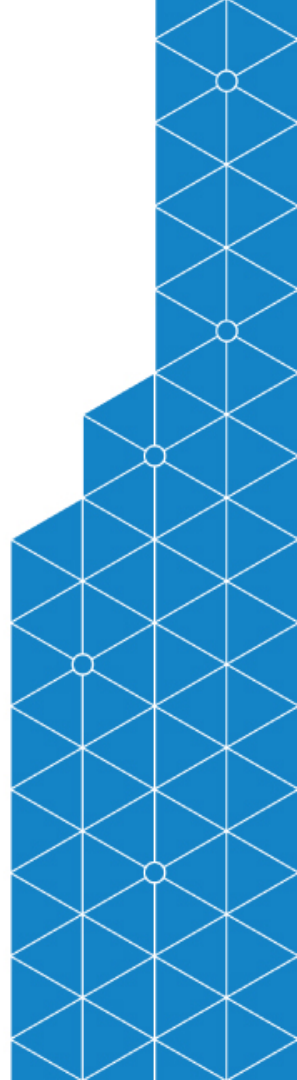


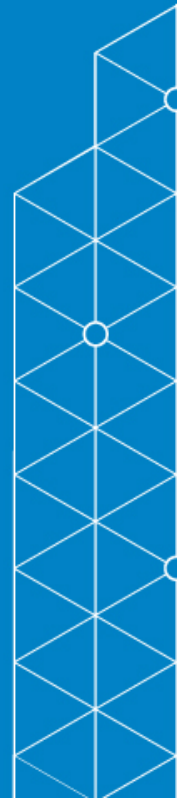

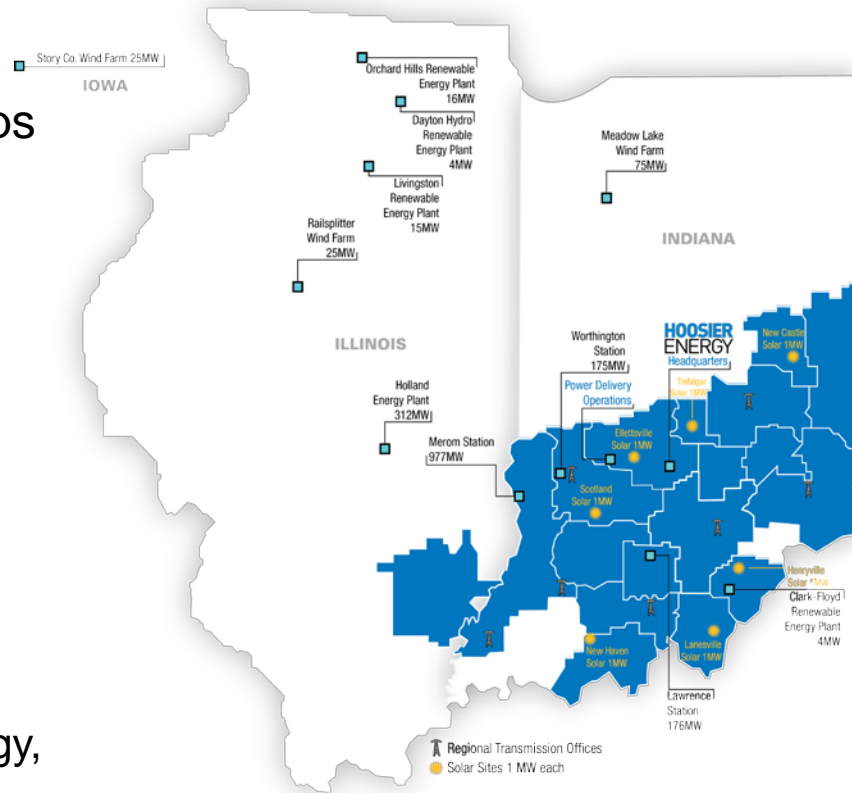


Hoosier Energy's Renewable Energy Program Overview



Hoosier Energy Renewables

- Not-for-profit, member owned cooperative with 18 member co-ops
- 10% renewable goal by 2025
 - In 2010, 100% coal
 - Today, 58% by capacity
- 17 renewable energy projects
- 4 technologies
 - Solar, Wind, Landfill Gas to Energy, and Hydro

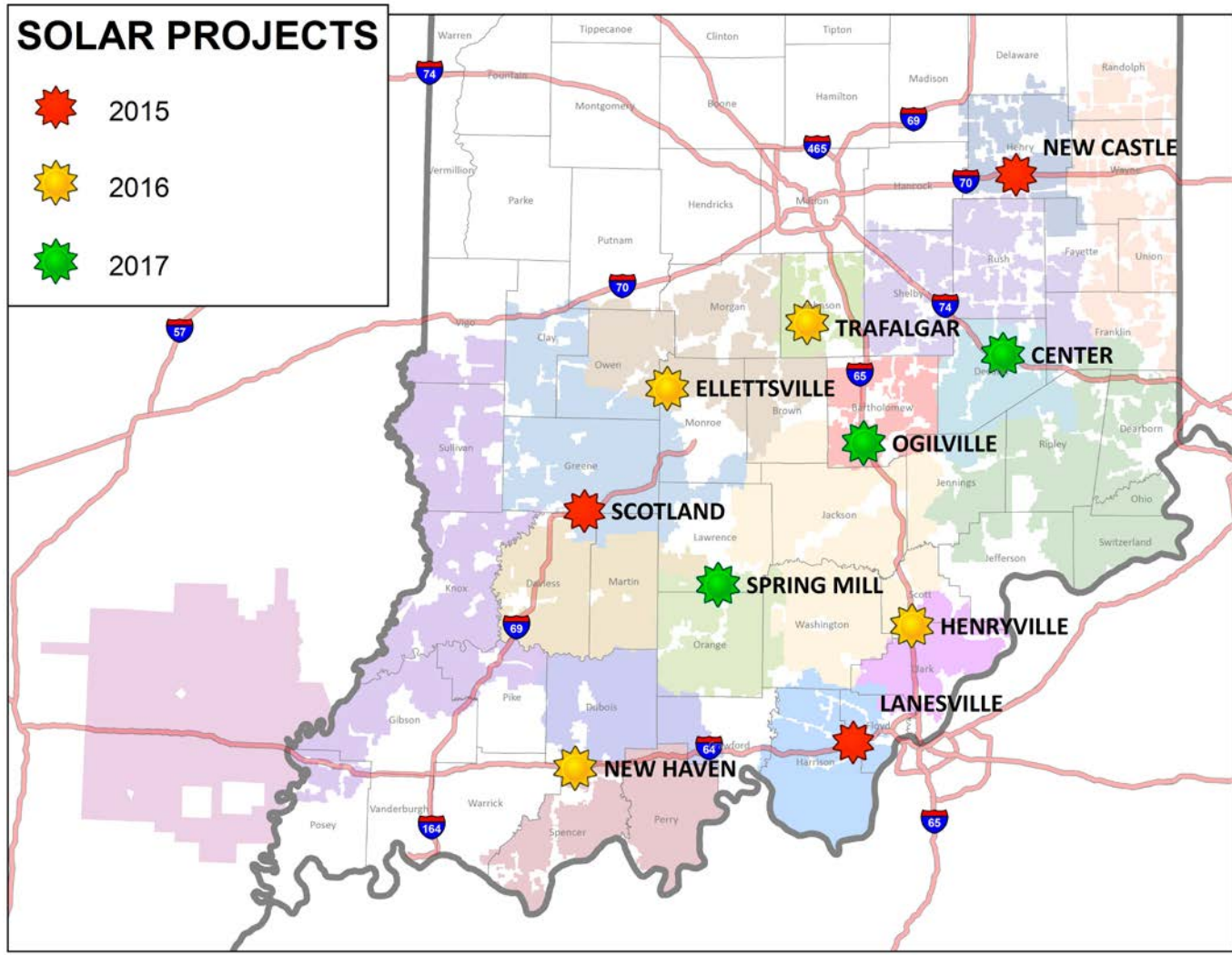

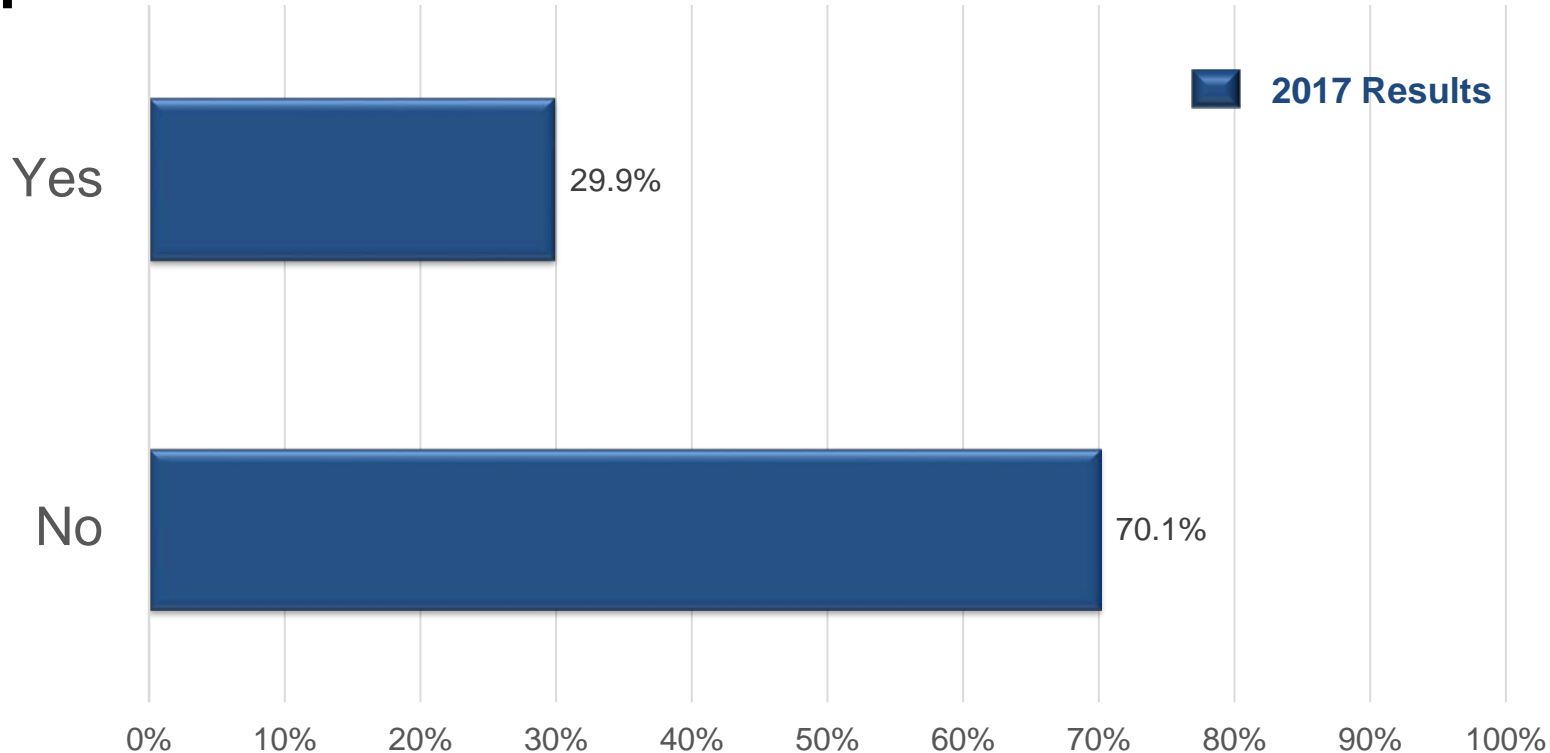
How important is it to use renewable energy to generate electricity?



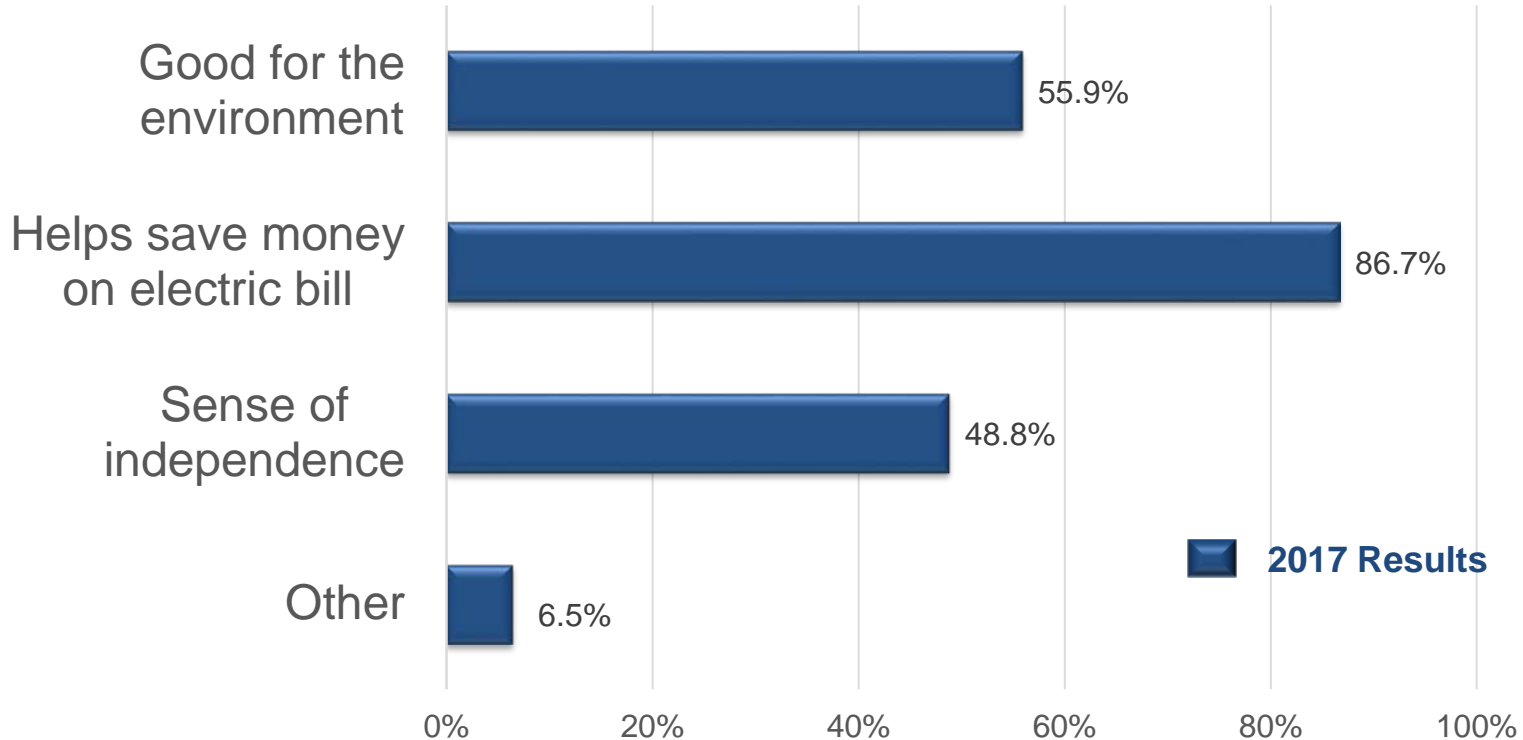
What percentage of power should your co-op provide from renewable energy?
